| About the Conference

VENUE

INFONOR-CHILE is organized by four universities affiliated to the CRUCH, located in the Northern Zone of Chile, and in 2025, it will be held at the University of Tarapacá, Arica.

Arica (officially San Marcos de Arica) is a city, commune and port of Chile, a capital of the homonymous province and of the Arica and Parinacota Region, located on the northern border of Chile, just 18 kilometers (11 miles) to the south of the border with Peru.

The city is known as the "City of Eternal Spring" for its beaches and pleasant climate, and as the "Northern Gate" of the country, due to its proximity to Peru and Bolivia.

Arica is characterized by a cultural, folkloric and ethnic diversity, and also by its historical past, highlighting the Chinchorro's mummies, considered among the oldest in the world.
