****Submission Guidelines****

MARBLE adopts a double-anonymous reviewing policy, i.e., all submissions must be anonymized and may not contain any identifying information of the authors. Submitted papers must be original and contain work that has not been published before or is under review elsewhere.

Accepted papers will be published by Springer Nature as part of the Springer Proceedings in Business and Economics book series (SPBE). The conference will accept novel research papers, systemization of knowledge (SoK) or review papers

and short papers. Full paper submissions of up to 16 pages and short paper submissions of up to 8 pages (including references) should be prepared according to the guidelines. Appendices are allowed, but will be considered at the reviewer's discretion.

If they wish, authors of accepted papers will also have the option to publish only a one-page abstract of the paper in the conference proceedings, along with a URL pointing to the full paper. Authors should guarantee the link to be reliable for at least two years. One-page abstracts will not be eligible for the best paper awards.
